1. INVOLVED CHANGES

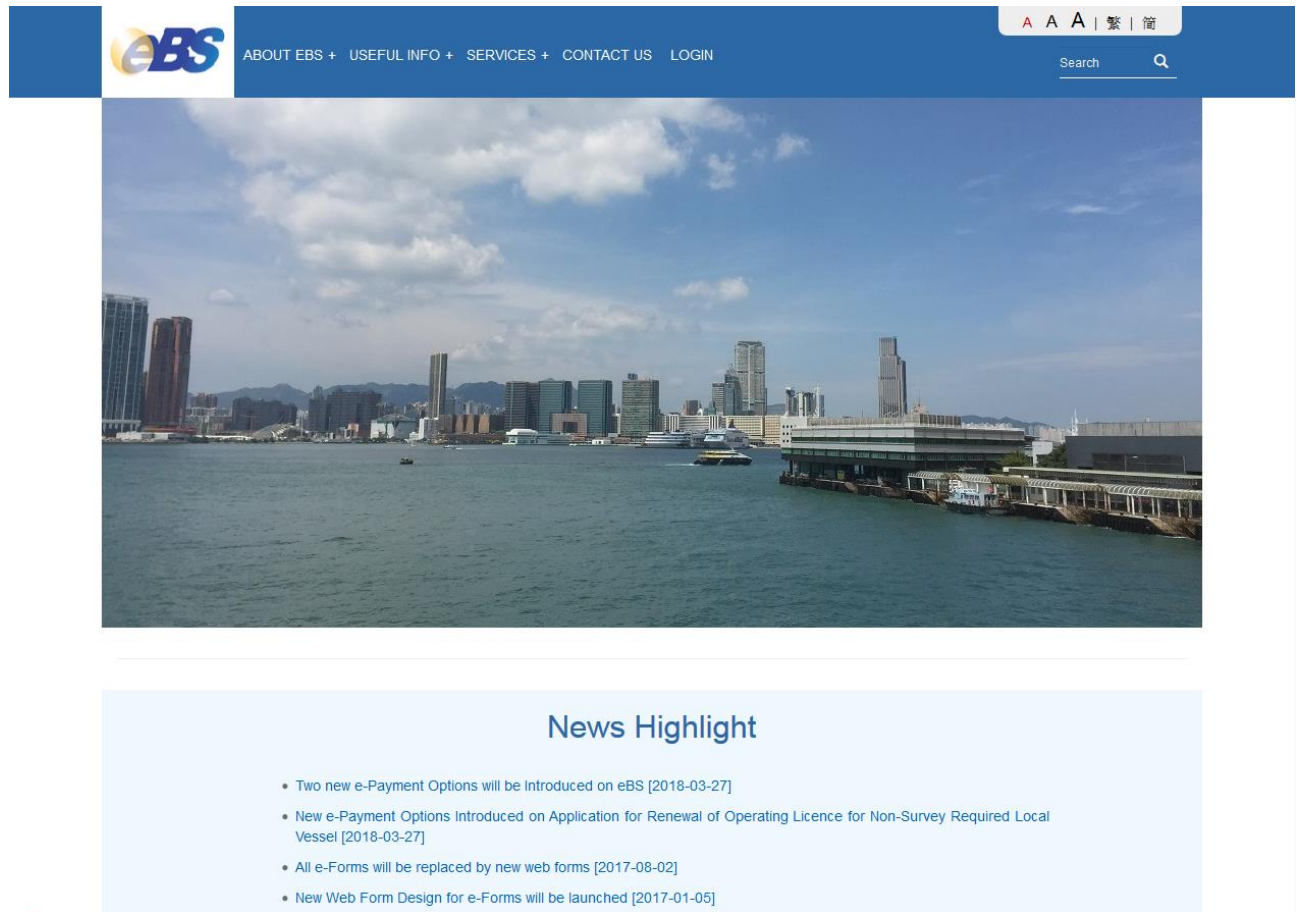
To keep up with the latest web technology, eBS has re-developed existing website. With effective from 2018-05-30, eBS website will adopt a new web design. However, the webpages after login will remain unchanged.

The new web design of eBS website conforms to the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Level AA requirements to the maximum extent possible.

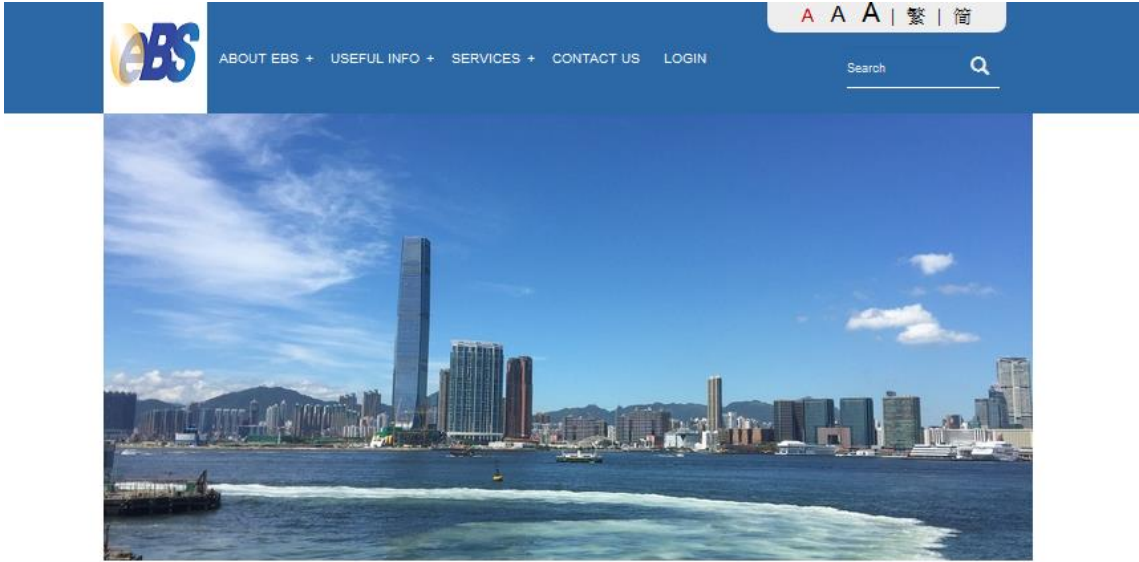

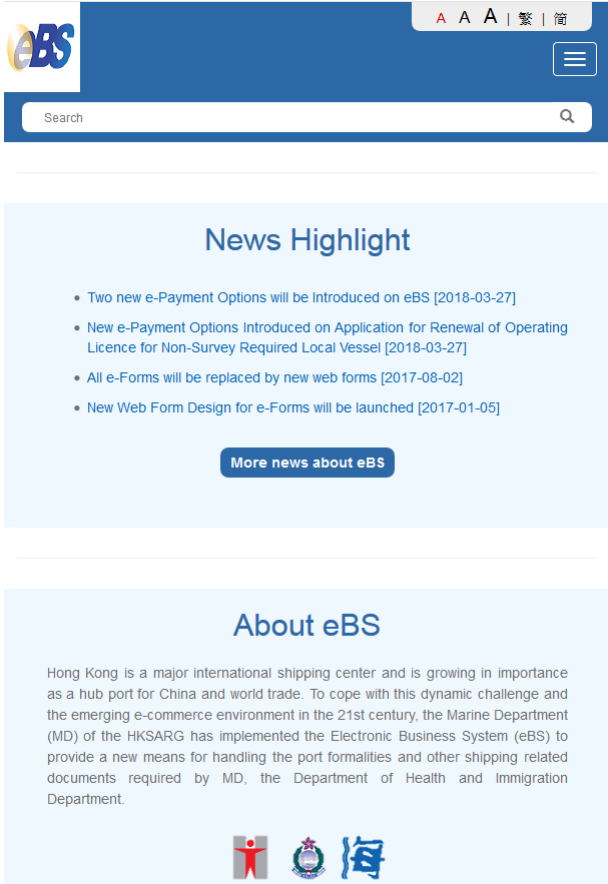
1 Desktop computer view



2 Tablet view



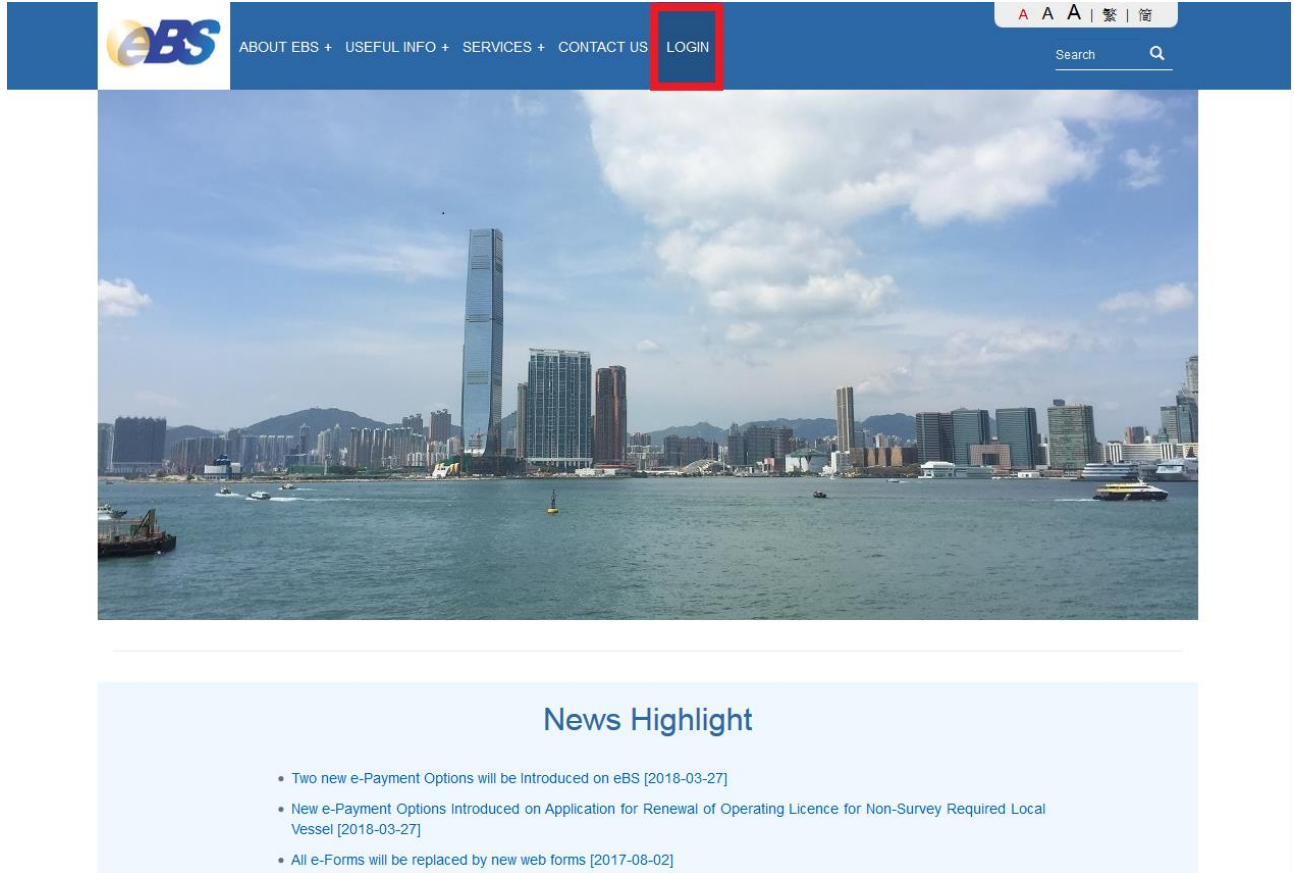

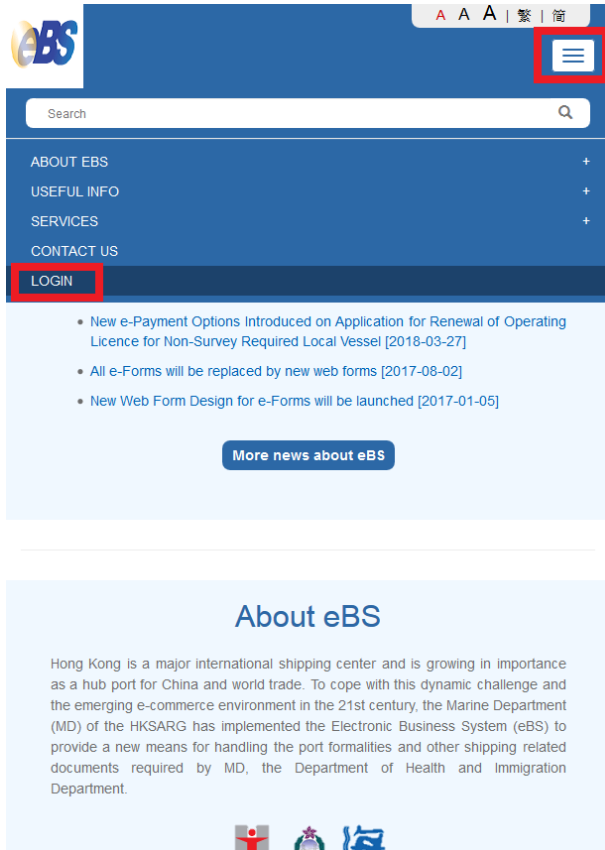

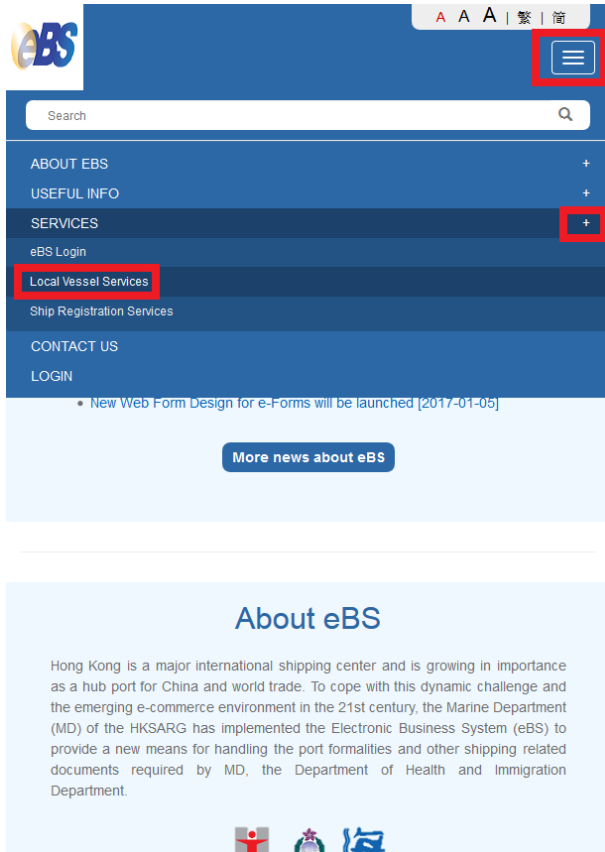
